Be notified when grants are announced:

- New York State Contract Reporter <u>www.nyscr.ny.gov</u>
 - All contracts are published in the Contract Reporter

- Grants Gateway <u>https://grantsgateway.ny.gov</u>
 - Majority of opportunities are published in the Gateway

Grant Opportunity Portal - Home

Welcome to the Grants Gateway

The Grant Opportunity Portal is online and available to the public, providing a one-stop shop for anyone interested in locating grant funding opportunities with State agencies.

The Grantee Document Vault is also available, allowing existing grantees and potential applicants to store key organizational information in a single secure online location for use by all State agencies. In order to use the Document Vault, a grantee must register as a user on the system and provide information on a Delegated Administrator who will manage their user account. This requires submission of a Registration form and accompanying organizational diagram. Note that your Registration form must be signed, notarized and mailed to Gateway Administrators. Plan accordingly to avoid potential delays in applying for upcoming grant opportunities.

Check back regularly as efforts to integrate with the Statewide Financial System are underway.

Grantee

- Can start and edit an Application
- Save application changes
- · Can't submit the application

Grantee Delegated Admin

- Add or Edit user accounts
- Manage Document Vault

Grantee Contract Signatory


- All Grantee abilities
- Can also submit the application
- There MUST be someone in this role for every organization

Grantee System Admin

- All Grantee and Grantee
 Contract Signatory abilities
- Additional admin abilities

NYSDEC Available Grant Opportunities

- 1. MWRR Recycling Coordination, Education, Planning and Promotion Projects. Annually in August 1st to October 31st.
- 2. Municipal Waste Reduction and Recycling Program Applications accepted continuously
- 3. 2019 Municipal Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Clean Vehicle (Purchase or Lease) Rebate Program Closes 7/24/20
- 4. 2019 Municipal Zero Emission Vehicle (ZEV) Infrastructure Grant Program Closes 5/29/20
- 5. UCF1-2019: Tree Inventory, Community Forest Management Plan- Opportunity Closes 12/4/19
- 6. UCF2-2019: Tree Planting & Tree Maintenance Opportunity Closes 12/4/19
- 7. UCF3-2019: Education Programming -Opportunity ends 12/4/19
- 8. Environmental Restoration Grants Program- Opportunity ends 12/13/19



Other Types of Grant Opportunities

- 1. Household Hazardous Waste Collection Program- Annually in February
- 2. Climate Smart Communities- Annually in May through the Consolidated Funding Application
- 3. Water Quality Improvement Projects- Annually in May through the Consolidated Funding Application
- 4. Hudson River Estuary- usually 2 to 3 different grant opportunities for projects in such areas as Stewardship, Education and Access.
- 5. Smart Growth Grant Opportunities in Catskills and Adirondacks
- 6. Invasive Species Grants
- 7. Mohawk River Grants
- 8. Environmental Justice Impact Grants
- 9. Technical Assistance Grants
